This designer will be primarily responsible for the production design of our in-house concert program books, but will also fill-in on special projects as needed.

Responsibilities

- Manage program book content updates based on layout template.
- Create unique editorial spreads (2-4 per book) that follow brand guidelines but bring a freshness to each book.
- Manage two-week timelines for design, vetting and edits.
- Meet or exceed all program book deadlines.
- Create and foster collaborative relationships with internal clients.
- Follow quality control processes in place with clients, art director and creative services manager – make recommendations for improvements.
- Carry out a concept from start to finish on your own with a strong understanding of color, color output, file preparation and press checks.

Qualifications

- Minimum 2-years' experience as a print designer creating branding and marketing concepts; previous experience as an in-house designer is a plus.
- Bachelor's degree in graphic design or related field preferred.
- A portfolio that demonstrates a strong command of typography both macro and micro, strong layout design, print and web design, experience with creating an entire campaign and part of a campaign following a style guide, and critical thinking skills.
- Self-starter who works efficiently and effectively in a fast-paced environment with shifting priorities.
- Willingness to learn and an ability to receive constructive criticism that you can absorb and apply quickly to any open projects.
- Ability to respond favorably to feedback, including creative differences and multiple revisions.
- Proficient iMac user with intermediate to advanced level in Adobe Creative Suite, specifically InDesign, Photoshop and Illustrator.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office software programs, especially Excel, PowerPoint and Word
