Anastasia Boudanoque is the founder of Primavera Consulting LLC, a firm that focuses on producing high-end classical entertainment events and consulting performing arts organizations all over the world. Additionally, Primavera represents a small roster of artists, reinforcing traditional talent management with digital and social media, endorsement opportunities, as well as educational, charitable and cultural diplomacy initiatives.

Ms. Boudanoque has been involved in the careers Lang Lang, Tan Dun, Mischa Maisky, Daniel Harding and Maxim Vengerov among others. As a producer, Ms. Boudanoque organized the 2010 Asian Games Festival in Guangzhou, bringing together Yo-Yo Ma and other top Asian artists for an unprecedented musical summit. She has produced five Chinese New Year Gala concerts at Lincoln Center with the New York Philharmonic and a special televised concert at the UN General Assembly, commemorating the 70th anniversary of Allied Powers’ victory over Nazism.

In 2019, Ms. Boudanoque released her second documentary. Filmed in eleven international locations, *Forté* profiles women who are challenging classical music industry norms by creating their own definition of success. Ms. Boudanoque graduated with honors from the St. Petersburg State University where she earned a Specialist degree in International Relations and Cultural Diplomacy.
