Chief Operating Officer, Los Angeles Philharmonic and Artistic Director, Ojai Music Festival

Chad Smith is the Chief Operating Officer for the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association. Smith joined the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association in 2002, serving as VP of artistic planning for over a decade before becoming COO in 2015. During his tenure, Mr. Smith has implemented an expansive vision of what an orchestra can be through a deep commitment to living composers, the development of multidisciplinary collaborations, and thematic festivals which have positioned the Philharmonic at the center of the city's cultural discourse. Committed to making classical music more inclusive, he has overseen the launch of many of the organization's defining educational programs, including YOLA, a program which has provided daily after-school music training to thousands of children in several of LA's most underserved communities.

He currently serves as Artistic Director of the Ojai Music Festival, a trustee of New England Conservatory of Music, as a member of Lincoln Center's Avery Fisher Prize executive committee and on the artistic advisory board for the Music Academy of the West.
