Emily Levin is the Principal Harpist with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra and Bronze Medal Winner of the 9th USA International Harp Competition. She has performed as Guest Principal Harp with the Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Houston Symphony, and regularly appears with the New York Philharmonic. As a soloist, Emily has performed throughout North America and Europe, in venues including Carnegie Hall, the Kimmel Center, the World Harp Congress, and Festspiele Mecklenburg-Vorpommern. In Dallas, Emily is the Artistic Director of the Fine Arts Chamber Players and is Adjunct Associate Instructor of Harp at Southern Methodist University. A graduate of The Juilliard School and Indiana University in both Music and History, Emily wrote her honors history thesis on the war songs of the French Revolution.
