Mark Volpe has played a major role in reaffirming the BSO's standing as one of the world's greatest orchestras during his tenure. He has maintained the orchestra's financial equilibrium in a challenging economic environment, while overseeing its artistic mission of musical excellence and bringing the BSO to the widest possible audience through live performances, educational outreach, traditional and new media, and a wide variety of social media platforms. Prior to the BSO, Mr. Volpe served as Executive Director of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, Vice President and General Manager of the Minnesota Orchestra, and General Manager of the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra. He obtained his Juris Doctorate from the University of Minnesota Law School as well as his bachelor's degree in clarinet performance from the Eastman School of Music of the University of Rochester.
